ABOUT OLE HEMMINGSHOLT

Ole Hemmingsholt, a native of Copenhagen, Denmark, opened his first school more than 30 years ago after discovering how widespread illiteracy was and the staggering effects it left in its wake: from escalating school dropout rates and the growing number of gangs, to difficulties with simple tasks such as filling out a job application. With a strong belief that education should not be a barrier for anyone to achieve their dreams, Ole dedicated himself to teaching students *how* to learn with Study Technology, a breakthrough method of learning discovered and developed by L. Ron Hubbard. The incredible results his students were able to achieve—200% jumps in literacy and near perfect graduation rates—prompted great interest and demand in Denmark and, in fact, all across Europe. To date, Ole has helped establish 325 learning groups, 25 schools and has empowered over 700,000 students with the tools that can help them master any subject.

The Scientology Network debuted on March 12, 2018. Since launching, the Scientology Network has been viewed in 237 countries and territories worldwide in 17 languages. Satisfying the curiosity of people about Scientology, the Network takes viewers across six continents, spotlighting the everyday lives of Scientologists; showing the Church as a global organization; and presenting its social betterment programs that have touched the lives of millions worldwide.
